TODAY'S SPEAKER

Dawn Morrison Armida Rose Residential Realty

Dawn was born in Brunswick Maine and grew up in Middleboro in southeast Massachusetts. She attended Syracuse University and got her degree in advertising and marketing communications. She got her first career job in NY city and supplemented her income by bartending. She moved to the Capital Region thirty years ago and worked in sales. She started her real estate career in 2018 and has a car service business for 18 years.

Dawn's friend owned the brokerage and in March 2019 Dawn got her real estate license. Dawn says it typically takes 8-10 years to get traction in the real estate business. Dawn is committed to giving VIP customer service in all she does and she has her clients' backs. She hired a real estate coach to keep her accountable to her goals and is currently working with a social media coach. She noted how advertising has changed in the 30 years since she got her degree in the field. She attended a real estate conference recently and learned the importance of video in social media to reinforce your personal brand.
