TODAY'S SPEAKER

Jeff Dorrance

Premium Mortgage Corp.

Jeff has been in banking since 1987. He started his career at Pioneer Savings Bank and worked for them for 24 years in lending and management positions. He then worked for TD Bank and managed commercial business programs in upstate NY and Vermont. After that he was a residential mortgage consultant with Wells Fargo.

Veteran-owned Premium Mortgage Corp. was opened in 1999 in Rochester. The Latham office has been open for over 5 years.

In Rochester and Buffalo, Premium is #1 in the market.

Jeff assists clients and helps them understand the mortgage process.

Jeff is licensed in NY and Florida. NY State has the most regulations on mortgage bankers, while Florida is like the "wild west".

Premium is not a broker, but a mortgage company that helps clients to get preapproval and get a contract.

Jeff takes applications via all media in addition to in-person meetings.

The company follows all FANNIEMAE and FREDDIEMAC guidelines.

Jeff pulls a credit report for a residential mortgage application. This will not affect the credit score. After reviewing the credit report, Jeff advises clients on how to clean up their credit, if necessary, so that they can get pre-approved.

Premium offers several programs to help people buy homes:

- Community Champions Program gives a \$1500 credit at closing to veterans, health care workers, educators and others.
- Building Home Ownership Program gives \$1000 in closing costs based on income
- Neighborhood Vitality Program gives a \$2000 credit toward closing costs to help grow home ownership in underserved areas.
- Buy Now, Refi Later get a mortgage by the end of the year and make 12 payments on time. If rates go down, Premium will waive some fees to refinance.
- Cash Guarantee Program helps buyers compete with all-cash buyers by providing a cash closing guarantee. Requires a minimum 10% cash deposit.

Most realtors currently require pre-approval before showing a house.

Mortgage rates are based on your credit score, purchase price, type of loan and whether or not you intend to purchase a point (1% of mortgage total)

Jeff's goal is to get his clients the best possible rate.
