# Mike Corey

LeChase Construction

Mike joined CDBL in 2018 and served as president in 2021.

He updated us on his family - Daughter Madeline is 13 and now in theater camp. Amelia is 10 and plays softball. Mike's wife Alice works for Pfizer. Formerly a sales rep, she now has a new job that's more patient-centric and is phasing out of sales.

Mike is originally from Victor, NY and attended SUNY Albany. His father worked for LeChase. Mike went to Australia to do his post-graduate work and got close to a family there. He went back five years ago with his family to visit and values the friendships he made there.

Mike gave the commencement speech at graduation.

In addition to CDBL, which he greatly values, Mike recently joined Toastmasters.

He also belongs to the American Wine Society, a national organization, and started a local chapter.

Around 10 years ago he began winemaking. He currently makes 2 batches a year and has a partner working with him.

Two years ago Mike took a test for the Level 2 of the Wine and Spirits Education Trust and passed. There are 4 levels and he is not sure if he will try for level 3. It's very challenging. Mike started working for LeChase at age 16, where he worked on site crews. He started working there full time after graduation doing project management, and started in business development five years ago. He's responsible for brand awareness and growing revenue, and focuses on the private sector.

Mlke explained that as construction manager, LeChase has more of a partnership with the client and gets engaged early to work out any issues before drawings are completed. The are also involved in the bid process.

LeChase has offices in NY and N. Carolina and serve the education, health care, science and technology industries. Clients include Global Foundries, St. Peters and Rivers Casino. They

don't just do large projects - 40% of their business is smaller projects. Mike's target is projects that are \$1M and above. Mike's accomplishments include a business development plan, more engagement with local teams and regional offices, and thorough and specific answering of RFPs. Mike concluded with 12 leadership messages from Ted Lasso (TV show FB coach) Believe in yourself To do the right thing is never wrong All people are different people See the good in others Courage is the ability to try Vulnerability is a strength, not a weakness Tell the truth Winning is an attitude Optimists do more Stay teachable Be a goldfish - they have a 10 second memory (let it go) Happiness is a choice.
