TODAY'S SPEAKER

Ann MacAffer CBRE Commercial Real Estate

Ann gave updates and fielded questions regarding the commercial real estate market:

Globally 18% of all rooms available for rent are short term rentals and are rented via the internet.

The warehouse market is slowing.

Mac.Bid is a business that takes returned items and sells them. They will be opening on Fuller Rd.

Ace Pickleball is looking for older retail sites with high ceilings for indoor pickleball facilities.

Overstock bought Bed, Bath & Beyond, which will come back this weekend.

Most Pyramid loans are in default. The Crossgates loan went to auction. The loan value is currently higher than the property value. Citi-JP Morgan owns the loan, valued at \$249M. They can foreclose the loan if they choose to.

Pyramid still manages the mall and owns the land and the majority of buildings.

Costco is starting to build this fall, renting land from Pyramid.

In the Capital Region office space market, 25% is physically vacant but still being paid for.

17 Plaza Dr. has a fully furnished restaurant that has never been used.

Some office space is being converted to residential apartments.

Rents in downtown Albany are going down, with a lot of vacancy.

The Central Warehouse will not be coming down. There are currently vagrants living in the building.

Shared work spaces are doing well.
