TODAY'S SPEAKER

Horrors and Successes

In lieu of a speaker, **Jeff Dorrance** asked members to share some of their business horror and success stories.

Horror: Jeff was recently working on a deal and found out the property title had three open liens that were over the sale price. Without a clean title the deal could not go through.

Success:Jeff had two contracts that successfully went through because the sellers and realtors saw the Premium pre-approval.

Horror: **Dan Fisk** of Woodlawn Doors has been working on a project at the Adelphi Hotel. The custom doors that were ordered could not be delivered on time, and then when they came they didn't fit because the customer hadn't measured the openings correctly.

Horror: **Terry Hamlin** of Card Connects got a call from a hotel saying that their credit card machines were not working. He went to help the client and found that they just had to be rebooted after a power failure.

Success: BBL Hospitality just opened 11 commercial accounts with Terry.

Success: **Will Berglund** of O'Connell & Aronowitz had a client who had fallen on hard times and had to file Chapter 13 bankruptcy. Will was able to work out a monthly payment that the client could afford to get him out of debt and back on his feet again.

Success: **Nick Marchese** took on a client with IRS problems. The client had been in business for 30 years without filing proper tax returns. Nick was able to get the client on a program that forgave all but 6 years of the taxes due.
