TODAY'S SPEAKER

Ann MacAffer CBRE

Ann said that CBRE held their Market View event last night.

The current office market is not good.

The average rent rate is pretty much the same as it has been.

Five year leases taken at the beginning of COVID are ending.

Companies are starting to bring more people back into the office.

The warehouse market is quiet.

The closing of Quad Graphics will make 1M sf space available and more will be coming on to the market.

New warehouse space is in the \$10/sf range, and used in the \$7 sf range

The Launch Box is a warehouse coworking space with a shared loading dock where smaller shippers can have warehouse space. Space sizes start at 500 sf and can be racked 4 high. Coworking spaces are doing fairly well and many are 1 year leases now rather than month to month.

Albany's C class buildings are being converted to apartments but some buildings are not suited to being converted to residential due to the layout and placement of windows.

The state still has many employees working at home and it is uncertain what they will do in the future.

Ann predicts a lot of movement, and a lot of medical space will be available.

Ann deals mostly in retail space. Malls are in a death spiral.

Colonie Center, Crossgates and Queensbury are the only malls that are doing well.

Bass Pro Shop is coming and will bring in other chain stores.

On Wolf Rd., Bed Bath and Beyond is out. Bank of America will be putting an office on part of that space.

Smashburger is going to be a dispensary.

Denny's will be a Community Bank and 99 Restaurant is closing.

Half of Shopper's Park is intentionally empty as they push out discount stores and try to attract higher end retail.

What will happen to the Turf is still a mystery.
The new Frank Adams Jewelers is complete.
